Statement of accreditation body AAC "Analitica"

due publication of new version ISO/IEC 17025:2017

International laboratory accreditation cooperation (ILAC) set 3 year transition period for implementation of new version of ISO/IEC 17025:2017. All laboratories must be evaluate accordance new edition of the standard no later than November, 30, 2020.

In this regard, AAC "Analitica" adopted a transition plan (see table below):

1	2018	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Amending internal documents of AB due publishing of new versions of ISO 17034, ISO/IEC 17025, ISO/IEC 17011;- Trainings and workshops for assessors and laboratories' personnel.
2	2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Performing of accreditations and re-accreditations according to new version of ISO/IEC 17025 (2,3,4 quarter of the year);- Performing surveillances of all* laboratories according to new version of ISO/IEC 17025;- Replacement of accreditation certificates (saving accreditation number and expiration date) in case of successful completion of surveillance
3	2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Completion of the surveillances according to new version of ISO/IEC 17025 (for laboratories planned surveillance on the 1st quarter of 2020) in case of successful completion of surveillance- December, 1st, 2020 - cancellation of accreditation certificates with expiration date after November, 30, 2020 – in case of unsuccessful completion of surveillance or surveillance evasion.

*Notes for laboratories:

1. If accreditation certificate expires at 2019 and 2020 (1st quarter of the year only), evaluation of laboratory's conformity could be performed during re-accreditation;
2. If accreditation certificate expires at 2020 (2,3,4 quarters of the year), 2021 and 2022, laboratories must be evaluated on ISO/IEC 17025 requirements during surveillance process.
